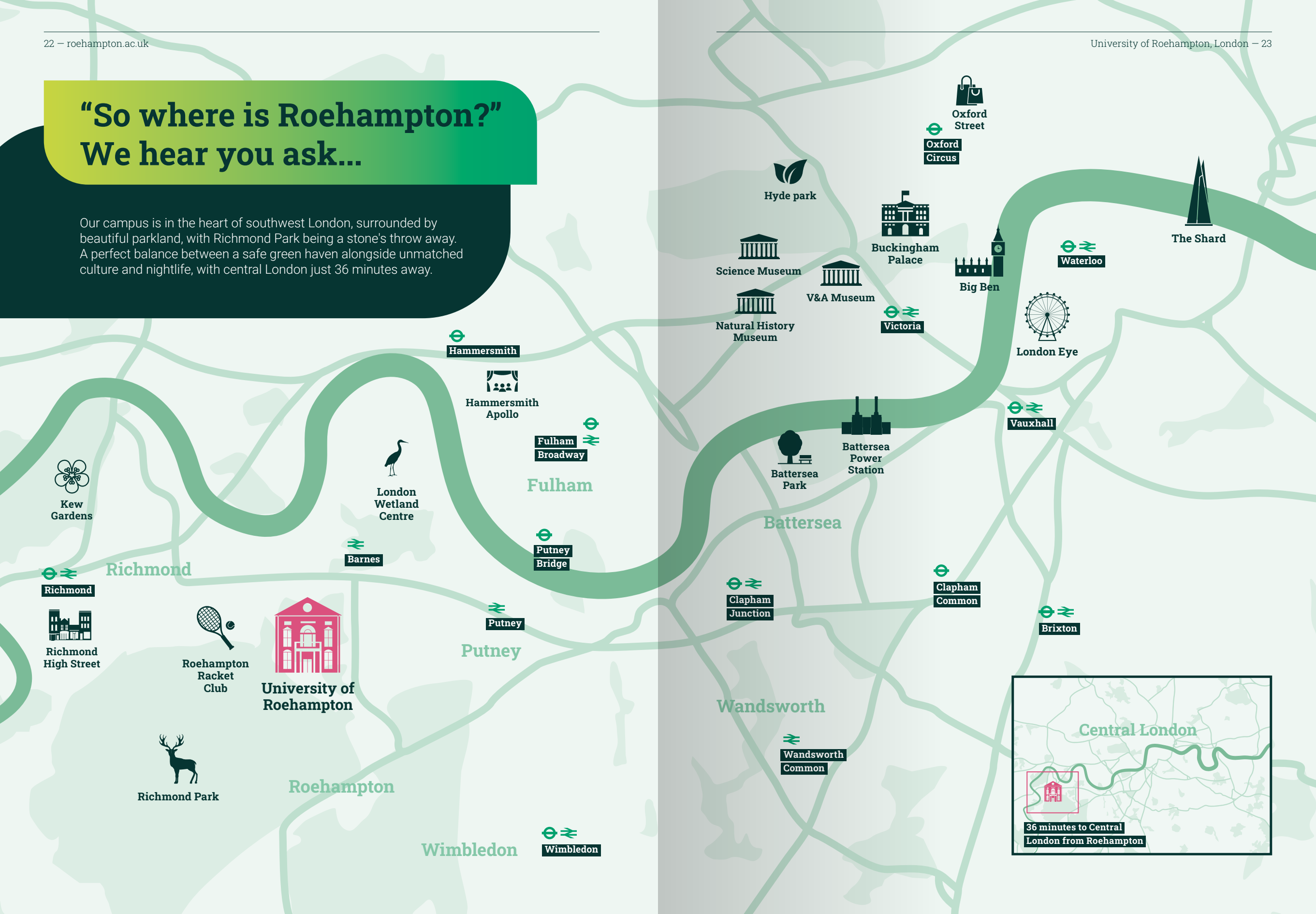

Richmond Park is a 7-minute walk from campus. Walk, run, cycle and see the local wildlife at London's largest Royal Park.

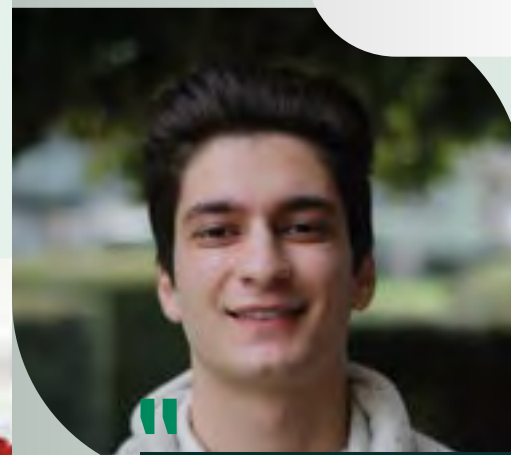
London's Southbank

Fees and funding

What fees will I pay?

Are you a UK student?

£9,535 per year on a full-time degree*

Are you an EU or international student?

£16,950 per year on a full-time degree*

*These figures were accurate at the time of printing in January 2025.

How do I pay the fees?

Tuition fee loan

Most UK students finance their studies with a Tuition Fee Loan from the UK government's Student Loans Company.

This loan covers the entire cost of your course fees, which are currently £9,535 per year, and is paid directly to the university.

Paying in instalments:

International students and self-funded students can opt to pay via an instalment plan.

How much will I pay back?

You won't need to start repayments until the April after you complete or leave your course, and your salary exceeds the current threshold of £25,000. Once your earnings are above this amount, your repayment amount will be determined based on your income. These repayments will cover both your Tuition Fee Loan and Maintenance Loan, combined into a single payment. And any remaining debt will be written off after 40 years, no matter how much you still owe.

Support and guidance and other resources

UK students can apply for a maintenance loan. The amount of loan you are eligible for depends on your family's income and where you'll be living while you're at university. The maintenance loan:

- Helps with your living costs
- Can be means tested
- Is paid directly to you at the start of each term.

Accommodation is guaranteed if students apply by the specified date, and fees are conveniently paid in three instalments, arranged at the start of each term after student loans are disbursed.

Student life and support

Roehampton provides countless opportunities to meet new people and try new activities. Our Students' Union hosts a wide variety of sports, lifestyle, and arts societies for everyone to join. Nest is a central hub for student life and support, assisting students with everything from booking wellbeing appointments to getting a new student ID card.

Wellbeing

Our students' wellbeing and safety are our top priorities. The RoeWellbeing App connects students directly to our wellbeing services. Student Wellbeing Officers are available to guide students on emotional support resources and can direct them to the appropriate mental health services. Our professional Counselling Team, Mental Health Advising Team, and Disabilities Team support students with disabilities, learning differences, and long-term health conditions.

Part-time jobs and future careers

We understand many students want to work part-time while studying. Our teaching timetable is designed to support this, offering flexibility for part-time jobs, placements, and internships so students can gain valuable real-world experience before they graduate.

Getting here

The University of Roehampton campus benefits from being at the heart of a busy network of transport links. Whether using buses, the tube network at Putney, or through rail services from Barnes to Waterloo, all points across London are within easy reach of the University.

Bus

We have a free bus, which runs between Putney Bridge tube, Barnes Station, our campus and our local supermarket, Asda.

The 265, 419, 493 and N74 buses stop outside the University's main entrance. Whitelands College, which is just down the road from main campus, also benefits from the 85 and 430 bus routes.

National Rail

The nearest station is Barnes, with trains running every 15 minutes to Putney, Clapham Junction, Vauxhall and London Waterloo.

Tube

We are a short bus ride away from tube connections at Putney Bridge (District).

If coming from Putney Bridge, take the 265 bus.

Cycle

Alternatively, you can create your own route and timetable by commuting to Roehampton by bike. We have secure bike storage, as well as shower facilities and lockers.

Car

We have free on-site parking, available to our students on a first-come first-served basis.

Airports

Heathrow Airport is approximately 13 miles from campus and easily accessible via the Piccadilly Line, national rail services, or by car in about 30 minutes.

Gatwick Airport is located about 28 miles away and is reachable in just 35-40 minutes by train from Clapham Junction, which is a short journey from campus.
